Rules for Kentucky Bourbon Festival – Kentucky Bourbon Shots

1. Kentucky Bourbon Shots Photography Contest is open to anyone who are 21 years of age or older. No purchase is necessary to enter.
2. The contest will run between May 3 and August 13. All entry forms and photographs must be received by the Kentucky Bourbon Festival office by the close of business on August 13, 2010. Late entries will not be accepted.
3. Photographs must include some aspect of Kentucky Bourbon.
4. A completed contest entry form must accompany each submission. Only entries with complete, accurate and legal information will be considered eligible entry forms must be signed and dated.
5. Previously published photographs may be disqualified.
6. Photographers may enter 1 photograph per category. Each entry must be listed on its own entry form and clearly identified on the photograph print.
7. Photographs must be a submitted in color or black and white print. A winner will be selected from each category.
8. Photographs that are modified or altered in any way including digitally or by other means **must and can only be** entered in the Modified category.
9. All photographs must be 5x7 and mounted on an 8x10 black matte.
10. Damaged photographs will not be accepted.
11. Photographs that are modified or altered in any way including digitally or by other means **must and can only be** entered in the Modified category.
12. The Kentucky Bourbon Festival or any associate of the festival are not responsible for late, lost , damaged, destroyed, or misdirected entries, or for miscommunications, misdirected transmissions, or other errors of any kind whether human, mechanical, or electronic.
13. Photographer retains all copyright privileges for their submitted photographs. Photographer grants unlimited, non-exclusive use license to Kentucky Bourbon Festival. Kentucky Bourbon Festival reserves the right to use the photographs in printed materials, including a published book for resale, and by electronic means in the promotion of the Kentucky Bourbon Festival and other activities of the festival.
14. Prizes will be awarded only to entries that are deemed worthy by the contest judges. If no acceptable entries are received in a category the prize for that category may not be awarded. All decisions by the judges are final
15. Any and all fees and other additional expenses associated with the awarded prizes are the responsibility of the winner.
16. Contest is void where restricted or prohibited by state or local laws
17. Employees and family members of the KBF employees are prohibited from participation in this contest.

18. Contest entrants agree to abide by the terms of these official rules and by the decisions of the judging organization, which are final on all matters pertaining to contests. The return of any prize/prize notification as undeliverable may result in disqualification and selection of an alternate winner.

19. If for any reason the contest is not capable of being conducted as planned including any causes beyond the control of the administrators of the contest, KBF reserves the right at its sole discretions to cancel modifies suspend or terminate the contest without notice to the entrants.

20. Photographs will not be returned at the end of the competition.

21. Photographs may be displayed at KBF events, in downtown shops, at the KBF office, etc. beginning 2 weeks prior to the beginning of the KBF week.
